Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

As another school year culminates, the Junior High School would like to inform you of the updated major guidelines on the selection of recipients of the different yearend awards. These various awards aim to recognise the outstanding performance of students in the different areas of school life.

1. Batch Overall Awards

1.1. Model Student – given to the best student of each grade level.

1.2. Top 5 of the Batch - given to the top 5 students in Grade 10 only

- 1.2.1. First Honor
- 1.2.2. Second Honor
- 1.2.3. Third Honor
- 1.2.4. First Honorable Mention
- 1.2.5. Second Honorable Mention

1.3. Selection Criteria:

Model Student: Top five students from each level who satisfy the following criteria for four quarters—

Top 5 of the Batch: Top ten students from Grade 10 who satisfy the following criteria for four quarters—

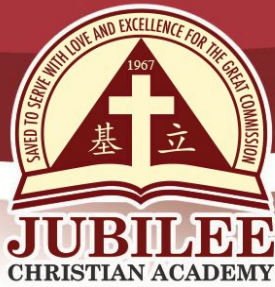
- 1.3.1. general average of 93 or above, without any failing grade in any quarter
- 1.3.2. Christian Education grade of 96 or above
- 1.3.3. department rating of /A/
- 1.3.4. active membership in a weekly activity (e.g., Student Council, Nouvelles, Praise Team, Youth Choir, training, varsity)
- 1.3.5. participation in at least one intraschool and one interschool competition
- 1.3.6. voluntary service to School and community

1.4. Award Criteria Weighted Ranks based on Final Grade (10)

As part of a more holistic search for the Model Student and Top 5 of the Grade 10, beginning SY 2018-2019, there will be a panel interview criterion given a weight of (1) one to evaluate the candidates on how they have been able to imbibe and live out the School's Philosophy, Vision, Mission, and Objectives (PVMO), core values, and school spirit.

- 1.4.1. academic excellence.....6
- 1.4.2. student activities.....2
- 1.4.3. Christian character..... 1
- 1.4.4. panel interview1

1.5. Tie breaker- final Grade Point Average (GPA) up to where tie is broken



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2. Bertrand Yu Lai Student Activities Excellence Award

2.1. Selection Criteria

- 2.1.1. general average of 83.00 or above, without any failing grade in any subject in any quarter
- 2.1.2. final department rating of /B/ or above
- 2.1.3. participation in two weekly clubs / varsity, or Student Activities
- 2.1.4. participation in two intraschool and two interschool competitions, and winning at least one of the top three places

2.2. Award Criteria Weighted Ranks (7)

- 2.2.1. membership in student activities.....2
- 2.2.2. performance in intra / interschool competition.....5

2.3. Tie-breaker- most number of highest award with 3 given to 1st place, 2 to 2nd place, and 1 to 3rd place

3. Christian Service Scholarship Award

3.1. Selection Criteria

- 3.1.1. general average of 83 or above without any failing grade in any quarter
- 3.1.2. final department rating of / B+ / or above
- 3.1.3. Christian Education / Community Care Club / Activities participation
- 3.1.4. Voluntary School / Christian church / community service

3.2. Award Criteria Weighted Ranks (6)

- 3.2.1. School Service.....4
- 3.2.2. Christian Church Service.....2

4. Exemplary Department Award

- 4.1. has consistent A department grades in all four quarters
- 4.2. has the highest numerical value in the final department grade in the level

5. Outstanding Varsity Player of the Team

5.1. Selection Criteria

- 5.1.1. general average of 83 or above without any failing grade in any quarter
- 5.1.2. final department rating of / B / or above

5.2. Award Criteria Weighted Ranks based on current school year (10)

- 5.2.1. Performance6
- 5.2.2. Character rating.....3
- 5.2.3. Voluntary service to School and community.....1

5.3. Tie-breaker- re-rating of the character criterion of the students who are tied for the top place

6. Teachers' Choice Award

- 6.1. no failing grade in any quarter
- 6.2. final department grade of / B / or above
- 6.3. has displayed consistent loving relationship and noteworthy service to JCA personnel, student, parent, or alumni



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7. Best in Mathematics and Best in Science

7.1. Selection Criteria: Top three students in the level

- 7.1.1. one of the top three Math / Science students in the level
- 7.1.2. participation in a Math / Science interschool competition
- 7.1.3. department rating of / B / or above

7.2. Award Criteria Ranks: highest Math / Science contest performance

7.3. Tie breaker- final Grade in Math /Science up to where tie is broken

8. JCA Merit Scholarship Award: Top 3 of the Junior High School students who participated in inter-school competitions in academic and sports

- 8.1. general average of 83.00 or above, without any failing grade in any subject in any quarter
- 8.2. final department rating of /B/ or above
- 8.3. winning at least three inter school competitions and with one 1st place
- 8.4. Tie-breaker: Grade Point Average (GPA) of the current schoolyear

9. Chinese Proficiency Award

9.1. Selection Criteria

- 9.1.1. top 10 in Chinese with grade of 96 or above in all quarters
- 9.1.2. department rating of /B/ or above
- 9.1.3. participation in an intra-school or inter-school Chinese competition

10. Gerry Roxas Leadership Award

10.1. Selection Criteria

- 10.1.1. awarded to a Grade 10 student
- 10.1.2. among the top 9 students of the batch
- 10.1.3. department rating of /A/
- 10.1.4. voluntary leadership to School and community service

10.2. Award Criteria Weighted Ranks

- 10.2.1. academic excellence2
- 10.2.2. department rating.....4
- 10.2.3. outstanding leadership service in student activities in School and community4

11. Subject Performance Certificate: awarded to a student with a final average of more than 100 in a subject at the end of the school year

- 11.1. Bronze - 101-110
- 11.2. Silver - 111-120
- 11.3. Gold - 121-130
- 11.4. Platinum - 131 or above

12. Official announcement to be done one day after the Academic Committee meeting; contestability period of three school days after official announcement of honors / awardees by the class advisers.

13. Any observed disciplinary offense that has merited a Violation Report would forfeit points earned in any of the listed criteria.
